They are producing plenty of milk, which is nourishing a very attractive & even line of marked & vaccinated FISH CREEK FARMS SPECKLE PARK sired calves. Presenting in fresh store condition these heifers are cleaning up in the coat, & would put considerable weight on quickly with access to fresher, more available feed. A great opportunity to secure very good quality, exceptionally quiet, young breeders with sappy Speckle Park calves at foot & a lifetime of production ahead of them. Another line of 16 heifers with black/white speckled Speckle Park sired calves at foot also on offer.
