of age, though this year are regrettably being sold due to dry seasonal conditions. These calves are extremely well handled, with emphasis on temperament and are yard weaned and up to date with animal health treatments. During the weaning process over 10 days calves were moved through yards and fed ryegrass and oaten silage and returned to paddock. Please note: approx. 2 steers showing old pink eye scarring and 1 steers with light ringworm, deemed not detrimental to sale. Vendor also has one other lot in sale averaging 300kg.
