Presenting in fresh store condition these heifers are cleaning up in the coat, & would put considerable weight on quickly with access to fresher, more available feed. A great opportunity to secure good quality, exceptionally quiet, young breeders with sappy Speckle Park calves at foot (displaying good muscling with the bonus of a black coat) & a lifetime of production ahead of them. 4 calves marked at assessment.
