Lambs have been grain trained and also been on a barley/lupin/pellet mix in the paddock on self feeders, trained to put straight into a feedlot. Shearing occurred mid January, and it must be noted that there is a slight rub on some lambs. There was a big 18 hr curfew on these lambs before they were weighed and every lamb in the mob was weighed for accuracy. Averaging 31.2kg curfewed at assesment. Lambs must go due to the testing conditions and emphasis put on ewes in lamb, a good article to tuck away while this lamb job is on the improve.
