These calves are extremely well handled, with emphasis on temperament and are yard weaned and up to date with animal health treatments. During the weaning process over 10 days calves were moved through yards and fed ryegrass and oaten silage and returned to paddock. Please note: Heifers are within a withholding, odd heifer with white under belly & Vendor has one other lot in sale.
