Out of large frame Angus cows that were bought in 2 years ago. 2 bulls were used with one being a Pharo Angus bull and the other 's bloodline is unknown. At assessment steers had a weight range of 351-423kg to avg 382.1kg. I deal steers to take home and either finish for the trade or quickly turn around into a feedlot article. Please note some steers have some mud on legs and underline that can be seen in video and pictures. Young steers you can buy with confidence. Vendor has 8 Heifers sisters in the same sale.
