Three heifers were purchased as calves off AuctionsPlus in Feb 2024. All heifers were PTIC 10/04/25. A list of EID vs weeks in calf is available on buyers request, as well as preg test certificate. Heifers have received two shots of 5 in 1 and have had Y-TeX Aggressor Fly Tags in since January. Vendor is only selling as they are due to calve outside of their preferred calving window.
