These lambs should reach trade & export weights if given the right nutrition. Good young lambs to take forward with strengthening winter markets ahead. There is the odd lamb with old fly strike scaring. I did also notice approx 10% with slight dag. Please note the vendor is offering another 230 lambs in this sale.
