These animals currently present in a forward store condition with a reasonable frame score that will give a prospective buyer a significant amount of compensatory growth if introduced to a warmer climate & greater feed availability. The season in our local area has been somewhat nonexistent and with continuous cold fronts approaching it has brought these animals on the market sooner than intended. Generally, the CaVag female will grow into a medium/large framed animal with a thick muscle pattern & all of the maternal traits you desire in the Angus breed.
