These young heifers have settled very well since they came off the cows last week and are extremely quiet. These soft heifers show plenty of shape and will fill many possible buyer requirements. These will tick all the boxes for a backgrounder to take to an oats crop or improved pastures and then onto domestic feeders, and being PCAS eligible will also suit all grassfed slaughter markets off grass. Above all they would be ideal to take through to heavier weights with the possibility to join up to your bulls of choice. They have been pre-treated for ticks with an injectable so hopefully they will clear but no guarantees can be given. These were drafted on colour and these are the creamy types. There is an additional light 2 decks of the red heifers that can be purchased to fill decks.
