Assessor Comments	A mostly good to very good quality line of predominantly purchased steers. With medium to large frame they suit to background to the top end of the export feeder steer market. They are also soft enough to take directly onto feed for the heavier end of the domestic market. Please note the photos were taken approx 60% of the way through the draft due to low sunlight and represent both lots. Both lots of steers were assessed and photographed together and they were split electronically into their sale and delivery mobs of 57 and 58 head for listing. Please note these cattle are in the tick free zone and a clear to travel of all areas. Two steers noted with slight blue eye spot in one eye and two steers with old fly rub marks cleaning up on neck and face. 27 steers from the purchased mobs were mouthed with all solid milk tooths. Nice quality steers that are soft in the coat and will move ahead quickly on crop or feed.
