Steers carry Ardrossan and Alpine Angus bloodlines, display good length, bone and type and have all the potential to carry big weights at a young age as they have proven in the past. Because of the season our southern weaners are certainly carrying more frame than their weight suggests, great opportunity to buy quality weaners ready to bounce.
