Majority have Good Feet, Tidy Heads & were 100% weighed, mouthed & assessed after 24 hours off feed & limited access to water. There is some Prickly Acacia in the paddock these Steers came out of, however it is not in seed at present. These Steers are 1 half of a "run of the gate" mob to fit on 4 decks.
