They are producing good milk, despite limited short feed, which is evident in the reasonably even, Angus sired, marked & vaccinated calves at foot, which are 3-10 weeks of age & exhibiting excellent shape at such a young age (13 steers/7 heifers). These heifers are displaying the characteristics & traits of being well bred, & are presenting in their working clothes due to a reduction in feed as a result of a lack of rain leading into Winter. Both cows & calves are set to thrive with access to more abundant fresh pastures. A great opportunity to secure a quality line of young Angus breeders coming into the prime of their production, which have calved unassisted to top quality Angus calves. With prime old cows currently selling well, they offer real value & an attractive change-over opportunity into younger breeders.
