They are vet preg tested as 5 - 8 months in calf to Moorobie Angus bulls (QBP22T150, QBP22T156, QBPR4, QBPR23) which were purchased as heifer suitable bulls. A file of heifer EID vs months in calf is available post sale on request. The heifers are by Gylanda & Kilterry bulls over Santa cross and Santa/Droughmaster cross cows and are in calf. The heifers are all vendor bred at either the vendors property in the Richmond district and then grown out and joined at Salisbury creek. The heifers were assessed as 5% small frame, 34% medium and 61% large frame. Two heifers have rub marks on the neck & face and another two with rub marks on tail from riding. Please note the vendor will follow fit to load guidelines around any heifer deemed close to calving at loading and will load a comfortable two decks in consultation with the buyer.
