Majority appear straight Angus however 1 is Black Baldy, 1 has a slight broken face and approximately 5 appear to have slight navel showing, these heifers show fantastic growth. Approximately 9 have slight white on udder or inside flank, still very acceptable. I regard these as a very good line of heifers that should throw a quality black calf with 100% Angus attributes. Calves weaned at assessment present as 100% Angus x Angus. I have included photos of weaned calves. 1 much lighter cow included due to being a productive cow and raising a big weaner.
