The calves at foot, which were marked & vaccinated at assessment (13 steers, 11 heifers), are mostly 10-14 weeks of age, bar one 4 week old calf. Heifers are presenting in their working clothes, displaying wooly coats, typical of this time of year & ranging from mostly store to a small percentage of fresher heifers. They have had access to only a short pick, due to dry Autumn conditions, however they possess the frame & bone structure to offer good compensatory weight gains with access to more abundant pastures. A great opportunity to secure a quality line of young breeders, with an even line of Angus calves at foot, Vendor is offering another a line of 17 x 17 top quality Angus first calvers this sale also, comprised in part, of 8 of the sisters to this mob.
