Please note some weaners are showing rub marks from lice, Vendor drenched with dectomax at weaning (5.8.25). Due to weaners being in the yards from Monday (4/8/25) It is best to be picked up as early as possible, These steers also need to be dropped in yards on delivery and purchaser make own assessment on further education.
