however present in store condition and are certainly not carrying any excess weight. Steers weighed between 200kg and 260kg, averaging 233kg at assessment. Usually these steers would be grown out to feeder weight and on fresh feed will not take long to get there. Please note some weaners are showing rub marks from lice, Vendor drenched with dectomax at weaning (5.8.25). Due to weaners being in the yards from Monday (4/8/25) It is best to be picked up as early as possible, These steers also need to be dropped in yards on delivery and purchaser make own assessment on further education.
