There are ring leaders that tend to move rapidly in the bigger yards and they need to be steadied down through a gateway, not unusual. Nothing in the mob that could be considered aggressive. Would encourage buyers to allow steers sufficient time to settle down on arrival prior to being shown the 'bush gate'. Would benefit from further weaning protocols and maybe tailed out.

They have presented in store condition after the winter, and I would suggest these will really hit their straps on improved pastures or crop so would expect plenty of compensatory gains. The heifers show adequate growth and are probably the younger heifers in the crop hence the light weight. They are genetically very sound cattle and ideal to put away to heavier domestic feedlot entry weights. They would also suit to grow out and use as future breeders. Very difficult to buy large lines of straight Santa future breeder females. Clean country buyers note they are offered GUARANTEED CLEAR of the dip & should clear the dip on Saturday
