Good medium framed heifers with a large percentage of polled heads. 100% weighed at assessment after being drafted the day before and off feed and water. 39 x 250-300kg, 70 x 300-350kg and 11hd 350kg +. 30hd in total mouthed with 100% of the #3's included in this number, break up was 19 x 2 tooth heifers balance 0 tooth. Mixed colours with the majority Black Brangus, small percentage of Charbray Droughtmaster and Composite types through the mob. These heifers have averaged just under 0.5kg/day since weaning at a light weight and are ready to continue on their journey as replacement breeders or trade on heifers.
