Assessor Comments	A line of fair to mostly good to very good quality medium to large frame Angus and Angus x heifers. These heifers are unjoined and were scanned at assessment and all are NDP. Approx 60% of the heifers are vendor bred and are by Lawson and Te Mania Angus bulls. All were mouthed at assessment with 42 x milk teeth and 9 x 2 teeth with most of the 2 teeth just breaking their milk teeth. Three heifers with a mild blue or moderate blue eye spot in one eye not considered detrimental . They have a LWR of 369 - 461 kg full weight and they suit to take directly onto feed for the heavy end of the domestic markets or the light export market. Please note another 2 decks of similar weight mostly Char x heifers from this vendor at their second property located 35km away. This is a nice line of Angus and Angus x heifers which are healthy and in ideal feedlot entry condition.
