Scanned at 162% to Tarella W/S (drys not included) to commence lambing 19th August for 6-7 weeks. March shorn, full 6 in 1 vaccinations plus a ewe guard every year at crutching. Drenched if required, seasonally. Bright, bulky and stylish wool cutters. An ideal line for someone to join annually to terminals or class and join to a Merino as a starter flock. A regretful sale by vendor, only selling due to seasonal conditions and lack of agistment availability for rising ewe hoggets. Buyers: fit to load standards apply for late term preg.
