The lambs have grown at an outstanding rate of 340g/hd per day since birth. Given a late start to the season these lambs have come through extremely well. They are fresh and have the potential to grow into quality trade or export weights. All replacement ewes on this property have been OJD vaccinated for 20+ years. With outstanding forward contracts out into the spring and later year these lambs should be bought with confidence.
