Assessor Comments	Noonamah bred Boonoke bld tops of the April/May 25 drop merino wether suckers. These lambs are 100% mulesed, vaccinated and displaying great weight for age, presenting fresh in condition and with continued quality feed will reach their full potential as wool cutters or for the kill. They have not had a set back and given the season is limited the value of the feed is second to none. 100% weighed at assessment to represent +41kg full to av 42.4kg empty, 45 kg full. Note 50% of this consignment was weighed after a 24 hour curfew (weighed +39kg to av 42kg) and were cross weaned at assess. Balance are still running on mothers and will be weaned at delivery. The top 2/3 of these lambs have been sold as suckers to the processors the past 2 seasons. Option available to top up to a b-double with the same weight specs off a neighbouring property. Lambs are gaining weight and this hasn't been applied to their +8 day delivery. #Delivery 12 or 15/09 and coordinating with the seconds is appreciated.
