As you can see in the photos these lambs are of excellent quality, with very good bone style and shape. These lambs are an ideal article for a quick top-up on grain and finish. No ewe lambs retained provides a very good opportunity to keep the ewe portion and they would also be a very good asset to any breeding flock. A tail of 5% were removed firstly under 25kg during assessment and then by eye for the remainder of the mob. **Please note that these lambs were drafted off their mothers for assessment and then returned post assessment.
