The lambs were born and bred on 'Wyvern Station' then trucked to 'Benangaroo' at weaning in early September 2025. These sheep annually perform very well in the Merino Wether Challenge trial run by Craig Wilson. At Wyvern we utilise the new WP index, all rams used are in the top 20% of this breeding index, and we breed for long term fleece value.
