Pure poll merino breeding for many years with Kamballie stud sires used last 10 years over the vendors nucleus flock. Prior to that was Willemenup genetics. Quality bright, white wool producing flock providing heavy cutting, bale filling potential. These ewes are suitable for all merino and crossbreeding enterprises.
