Adult flock average at shearing 2025 was between 19 - 20 micron. The young ewes when shorn in April generally cut between 7-8 kg of wool. The season has been late, with green feed only making its appearance in July, and the ewes have filled out in the last 7-8 weeks, and will continue to do so on good feed. The feed is just starting to dry off at present. 16.5% tail removed from mob prior to assessment. Average weight was 40.8 kg at assessment.
