The heifer mouthed as a 2-tooth is only just cutting them now. All mainly 'flatback' types with limited content in them (see photos/video). They look to be on the move, and I would expect these to really hit their straps once they get onto some good fattening feed. Please note there are two lines of heifers in this sale from the same vendor. All guaranteed for clean country entry and will scratch clean on farm.
