These heifer should power ahead on good feed, ideally suited to take through to Domestic or Export feeder weight or alternatively most have the feminine characteristics to go into a breeding herd. Please note some showing signs of lice rub and 1 heifer observed with old blight scar in 1 eye with neither considered detrimental.
