The steers are very quiet; the vendor's always do an excellent job throughout the weaning process and is reflected in these. They possess plenty of length and depth of barrel and don't look to have had any health setbacks at any stage of their life. The steers are just starting to clean up in the coat, they are healthy, and I would suggest these will fly ahead if they get access to improved pastures or crop especially on heavier country. All the hard work is done; they are well and truly over the weaning process. Ideal to put away and background to heavier weights and meet all export feeder specs next year. Cattle from Wongavale are continually attracting repeat buyers, evidence they must perform.
