THE HEIFERS POSSESS GOOD WEIGHT FOR AGE AND WHILE MAJORITY ARE IN FORWARD STORE CONDITION IT WAS NOTED AT ASSESSMENT EVEN WITH MINIMAL OATS LEFT FOR STOCK TO GET A HOLD OF THESE HEIFERS HAD REALLY CLEANED UP AND PILED THE WEIGHT ON SINCE LAST INSPECTION A FORTNIGHT AGO.
