They are Heifers that will make for front paddock cows. As you can see by the videos they have the frame, conformation and muscle pattern you would expect from the Millah Murrah blood lines. The breeder has selected bulls on type not price and this shows through. A few have a skin reaction around the eyes from the hay feeders (see photos). Two have a splash of white (one behind the udder, one on the face) and can be taken out if required. There is another 2 lots of Steers from this breeder also in this sale.
