Cows have bloodlines based on Langi Kal Kal & Barwidgee Angus, & are predominantly 2nd & 3rd calvers with 3 cows in the mob, rising 5 years, & on their 4th calf. All cows have reared a calf every year they have been joined. Cows are showing good conformation & are maintaining an ample supply of milk, which is nourishing the very fresh calves at foot, which have been marked & vaccinated, & numbered heavily in favour of the steer portion. (14 str/4 hfr). Cows are presenting in fresh store condition, & would benefit from a backline, however they possess the frame & bone structure to offer good compensatory weight gains with access to more abundant pastures or forage crop especially coming into Spring. A great opportunity to secure a hard to find, top quality line of young to middle-aged breeders, with a very even line of sappy Angus calves at foot.
