They are producing a good supply of milk, which is nourishing the fresh, young calves at foot, which were marked & vaccinated at assessment. Heifers are presenting in fresh to forward store condition & are moving forward in condition, as they shed their winter coats and start to shine up. They possess adequate bone structure, & a reputation for 'doing ability' to put considerable weight on quickly with the warmer weather & the feed hardening up as it seeds. A great opportunity to secure a good quality line of young breeders, with an even line of young Angus calves at foot. Ideal units to improve quickly by adding weight, & in turn, value.
