They are starting to clean up in the coat with the warmer weather, & are just starting to move forward in condition, on more available feed. With the calf now on the ground, they offer a good opportunity to add considerable weight & value quickly. These heifers have large, well developed udders & are doing a terrific job nurturing a very even drop of sappy calves at foot which are exuding quality & very good weight for age. Calves have been not been marked just vaccinated at assessment, with a very large percentage of steer calves, outnumbering the heifers, making them an attractive proposition for future increased value of the calves into feeder markets. The bloodlines of these young heifers are Merridale Blood. A great opportunity to capitalize on quality bred heifers with good calves
