Heifers present as mostly medium to good frame, having largely been given the opportunity to mature to 1.5 year olds before being joined. They are producing a good supply of milk, which is nourishing an attractive line of marked & vaccinated EASTERN PLAINS ANGUS sired calves at foot. Presenting in fresh store condition these heifers are starting to clean up in the coat & are starting to move forward in condition as the weather warms & the feed hardens up. Approx 5 cows were observed to have a small percentage of cross in the breeding, with 2 heifers showing traits of slight Santa influence, & some Hereford influence in the other 3, with minor white on underline. Great opportunity to replace old breeders with 1st calvers at favourable changeover rates
