Vendor bred portion of heifers are by high indexing Ardrossan Angus bulls and the balance of them are all once removed cattle sourced off Auctionsplus locally or from Southern regions. This line of cattle given their age and weight would be ideal to feed or alternatively would be an excellent group to breed from.
