These steers are usually grown out to feeder weight but have come through a tough season and will be unrecognisable in a month on fresh feed. Steers weighed between 260kg and 340kg, averaging 291kg at assessment and have just begin to do in the last week. Please note some steers are showing rub marks from lice, Vendor has drenched with cattlemax (4.8.25).
