Steers have been in a rotational grazing program and are handled every few days when walking them into their next cell, the cattle are trained to one wire electric fencing. Ideal trade types to grow on to heavy feeders or domestic trade weights. A sound opportunity to secure a line of well shaped Angus steers performing well under excellent Tablelands seasonal conditions.
