Cattle are often yarded on foot or by being called, with the temperament displayed being a true result of a limited stress environment. Heifers are sired by Witherswood bulls out of a Glenruben blood cow herd. Bulls are selected with a focus on temperament, feet, depth and length of the body, with these heifers being a prime		

example of all. With years of well bred breeding, this article would be ideal to target multiple avenues such as feeder, trade or export markets or to add to a breeding program. Proven performers with numerous repeat buyers coming back due to the product produced by the operation. With so much potential in these heifers, they are an article not to be missed.
