Assessor Comments	Buyers, here are 6 decks of yearling steers that are PCAS ELIGIBLE and being offered in two B-Doubles and will be delivered in even lots . Present in mainly store condition, they will offer buyers plenty of compensatory weight gains when introduced to crop, grass or grain. Had a big sweat in the yards prior to assessment further emphasizing possible compensatory gain. Plenty of frame, not much condition so it shouldn't take long to get them to heavier export feedlot entry weights or right through to bullocks. Most steers yet again exhibit softness, good bone, length, depth of barrel and weight for age. Of the 180 in the run 160 of these steers range from 320-380kgs with only 20 head heavier. The vendors are very careful when choosing their bulls annually and not frightened to spend for the right article, often surpassing the \$20,000 mark at Cree Santa sale. Receiving excellent feedback from past buyers about their performance. Beef industry looks secure so buy these with confidence.
