They are generally well grown maidens with the majority medium framed, a few large frame & a few small frame, as can be seen by the weights & photos. These breeders are due to finish calving by the 19th of November approximately. They were pre treated for ticks with Dectomax injectable 25/10. This line suits breeding on with or fattening & splitting. I recommend this line of maiden station mated heifers and calves.
