Heifers are WIRRUNA HEREFORD blood with marked & vaccinated calves at foot sired by registered WIRRUNA sires.The depth of breeding quality is clearly visible throughout these cattle, with the heifers exhibiting good frame & depth of bone, & the calves showcasing very good carcass shape & softness, with sound growth rates for age. These cattle are showing the effects of the current dry, windy conditions with a little bit of pinkeye & dusty-eye weep prevalent throughout a few heifers & calves in the mob, which has been treated accordingly with Orbenin cream. 1 heifer & 2 calves have slight lumps around the jaw
