Heifers did have access to the neighbour's bull overnight in December, however they were treated with a PG afterwards (see assessment's previous details). Donnelly cattle have previously performed well in the feedlots, heifers should make a quality feeder heifer. Alternatively, join and get a quality calf down the track.
