Genetically bred by large framed (600-800kg cows) quality Reiland and Hazeldean bld Angus dams and sired by a Reiland and a Bongongo bull. They are carrying years of genetic investment and are the result of a meticulous classing program. The quality of the genetics used and the strict selection criteria for replacement heifers is evident in the temperament and growth of these steers given their weight at 7-9 months of age. These steers have previously sold to repeat buyers and have been grown out to bullocks when required.
