They show excellent weight and growth for age, with plenty of frame and the capacity for further significant weight gain. Temperament wise they are a docile line of steers to work with, and handled quietly through the crush. Only 1 arced up slightly under pressure. All in all, a very neat and tidy line of weaned steers.
