Steers were sired by sired by Milwillah and Te Mania bulls with a strong influence from Te Mania Kirby & Milwillah Proceed bulls selected for IMF & structure. All sire bulls used are within the top 20% of the breed for IMF. Heifers were yard weaned and bunk trained on the 20/01/25 - fed with Amplified 16% protien weaner pellets and barley straw. Heifers are immune ready - treated with Rhino-guard and Bovishield MH-one at marking. These heifers provide an opportunity to purchase young future breeders carrying highly reputable bloodlines. Out of a fertile cow herd - with last years retained heifers achieving 66% first round AI, 84% after AI and bull for one cycle. These heifers are still performing well considering the current seasonal conditions. Heifers would normally be kept and AI'd in September - selling due to the deteriorating season.
