They were pregnancy tested in calf by Brad Pickford on the 19th of January & are due to calve over a 4 week period starting March 24th. Cows present in prime condition & have proven to breed fast growing calves that can thrive under tough conditions. The heifer calves have recently been sought after by repeat purchasers to enter joining programs. There is 1 Black Baldy cow in this mob that the buyer can take or leave at their discretion. ** Vendor has another lot of cows, also drafted into 4 week calving groups in this sale**
